

Our nurses assist members with a variety of seasonal, situational, and age-related ailments. Helping a member understand the importance of their medication, taking it properly, doctor’s instructions, and assisting in scheduling appointments is all a part of their mission. The nurses are first-responders for members and provide counsel for the staff dealing with issues of mental health or addiction. The availability and resources provided by the nurses ensure that a minor condition doesn’t develop into a major challenge that requires hospitalization or worse.

As the population of homeless senior grows and ages, the need for our nurses and resources increases. In 2018, the nurses expanded from 3-days per week to a 5-days per week operation with nearly 2,000 patient visits. In 2019, a one-Saturday per month clinic is planned.

The resources required to manage minor conditions are often lost or are unaffordable when living on the streets. Donors providing financial support and contributing supplies ensure that the nurses can continue to provide for our members. Thank you for your ongoing support.
